


Graded Homework Assignments

Faculty will assign quizzes called Graded Homework Assignments (GHA) during a course. GHAs can be made up of different types of questions such as true/false, multiple choice, fill in the blanks and short essays. To take a GHA first click on the Course Material link in the Navigation Panel.

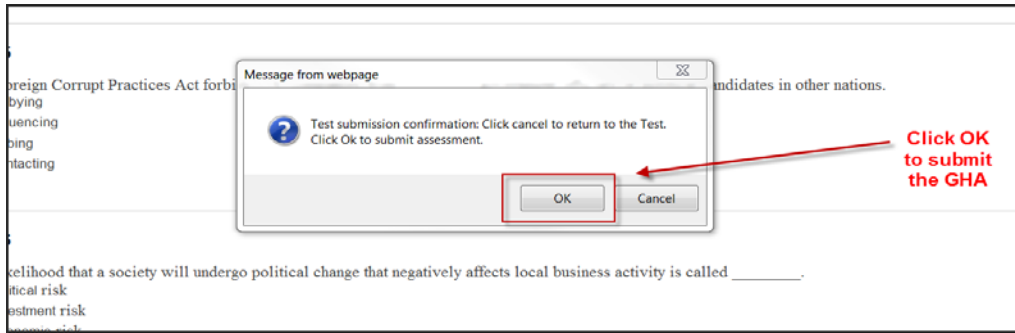

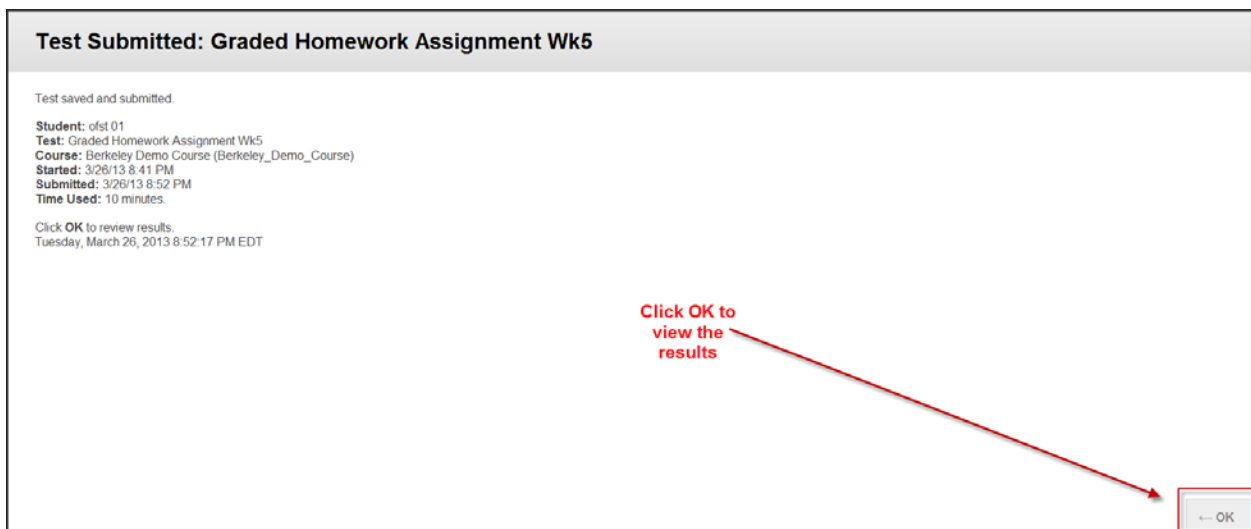

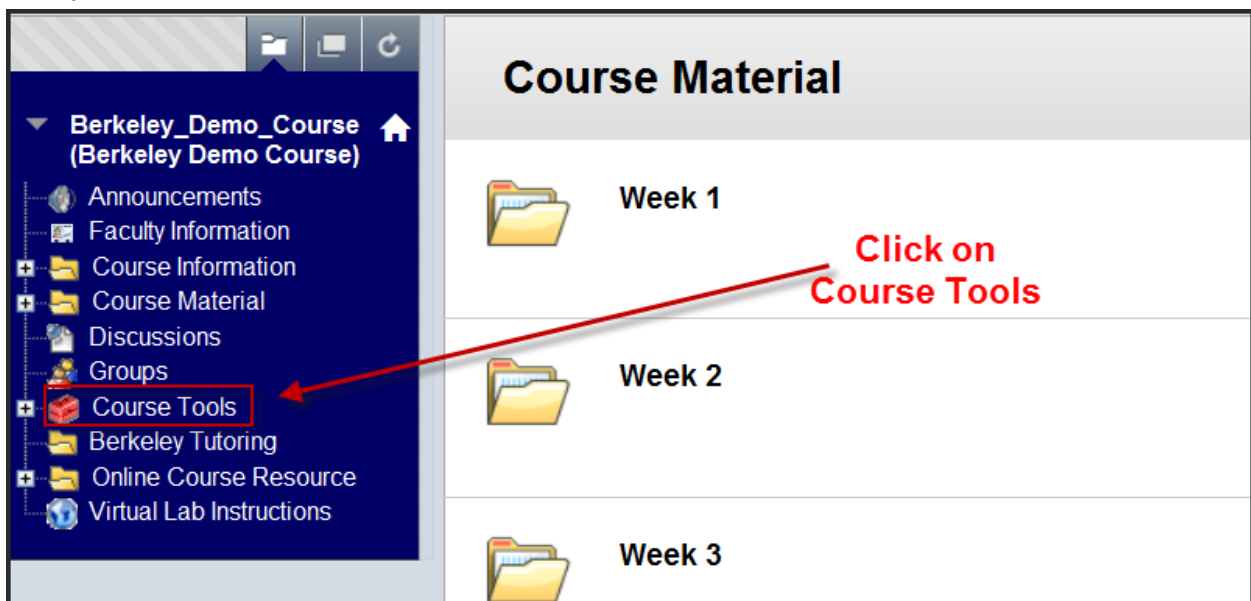
Next the Test submission confirmation window opens. Click OK to submit the GHA.




A confirmation page appears indicating the GHA was successfully submitted; click OK to review the results.
