

# Attention Juniors and Seniors: Get started on your college credits!



## FASHION



Berkeley College is offering two online courses for qualified high school juniors and seniors. You may be able to earn college credits and enjoy a substantial discount on tuition!

## The courses:

### Introduction to Fashion (3 credits)

Provides an overview of the fashion industry and its global reach. This course familiarizes students with fashion history and key milestones. Students learn about business categories including women's, men's, and children's ready-to-wear, accessories, shoes, innerwear, and outerwear. Further topics include consumer behaviors, marketing, product development, and sales.

**When:** Courses run from **September 4 - December 17, 2018**

**Where:** In these online courses, students can study wherever an Internet connection is available and permitted by law.

**Who is eligible:** High school juniors and seniors with a HS GPA of 2.6 and above are eligible. Students must be approved by a high school guidance counselor or other school official based on the student's academic performance and ability to handle college-level coursework.

**Cost:** Eligible students receive a special discounted tuition of just \$150 for this three-credit course, including e-books—a significant savings!

**Are the credits transferable? Students will receive college credit only after successfully completing the course and graduating from high school.** Berkeley College is an institution of higher education accredited by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education, a respected regional accreditation body. Introduction to Fashion or Entrepreneurship credits can be applied in programs where they are required, or used as electives. Although credits earned at Berkeley College are typically accepted as transfer credits by other colleges, the decision to award transfer credit is solely within the discretion of the institution from which such credit is sought. Students are advised to consult with the college to which they may seek to transfer.

### Entrepreneurship (3 credits)

Examines the conversion of ideas into successful business ventures. Topics include developing ideas for entrepreneurial ventures, testing the feasibility of an idea, evaluating the lifestyle considerations of business ownership, preparing business plans, seeking expert advice, securing financing, and avoiding common pitfalls.

Students will receive an unofficial transcript upon satisfactory completion of the Dual Enrollment Program. To receive an official transcript, students must submit a request to Berkeley College and provide proof of satisfying state graduation requirements (e.g. copy of high school diploma).
