To qualify for graduation, students must participate in the Certified Professional Biller examination (CPB) through the AAPC or the Certified Billing and Coding Specialist examination (CBCS) through the National Healthcareer Association (NHA) — both are nationally accepted standards of achievement in the administrative part of the field. Although certification is not required to work in most states, employers may require the CPB or CBCS credential or prefer to hire candidates who have obtained the CPB or CBCS credential.
