Berkeley's internship program

- Many Berkeley College programs include an internship, job-related assignment, or practicum for a valuable learning experience.
- Students receive academic credit for the internship, including participation in an online internship class.
- Students intern approximately eight hours per week and are required to complete a minimum of 120 hours during the semester.
- All internship hours, including projects and assignments, must be under the direct supervision of the internship employer.
- Internship supervisors are required to complete an evaluation at end of semester.
- Semesters start in January, April, and September.
