- 1) Goto the App Store and search for "Microsoft Remote Desktop connection" and download (Link Below)

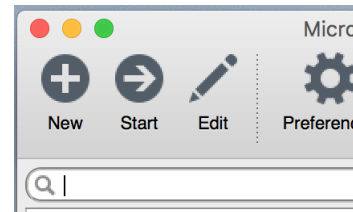
What's New in Version 8.0.42

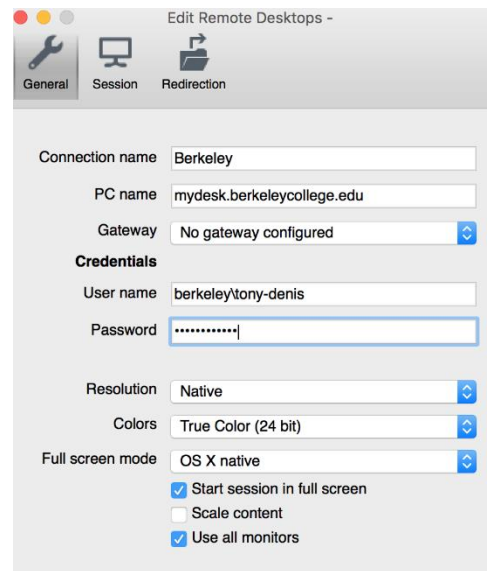
