The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund ("HEERF") established in accordance with Section 18004 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security ("CARES") Act allows institutions of higher education to provide an emergency financial aid grant ("CARES Grant") from the HEERF to students for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus (including eligible expenses under a student's cost of attendance, such as food, housing, course materials, technology, healthcare, and child care).

Eligible Berkeley College students may use this application to request a CARES Grant. Funds are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. Approved CARES Grants will be disbursed directly to students via their BankMobile accounts. The application deadline is June 26, 2020. To be eligible for a CARES Grant, a student must:

(1) have incurred expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus (including eligible expenses under a student's cost of attendance, such as food, housing, course materials, technology, healthcare, and child care);

(2) have been enrolled in at least one onsite course at Berkeley College during the Winter 2020 semester and remained enrolled through at least March 13, 2020;

(3) have been matriculated in a certificate or degree program on March 13, 2020; and

(4) meet the general requirements for federal financial aid. One of those requirements is the student must submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), which results in the college receiving a valid and "C" Comment clean Institutional Student Information Report (ISIR) for the 19-20 aid year. The ISIR is what the college receives as a result of a student filing the FAFSA.
