Berkeley College Vaccination Policy for Students

<u>Purpose</u>

Berkeley College holds as paramount the health and safety of every member of its community. Maintaining a safe workplace is a shared responsibility. The purpose of this policy is to further the College's efforts to mitigate the risk of coronavirus (COVID-19) exposure. All College students who are on-campus are strongly encouraged to be vaccinated for COVID-19.

<u>Scope</u>

This policy applies to all students.

<u>Policy</u>

All students are strongly encouraged to receive one of the COVID-19 vaccines authorized by the FDA. Individuals are generally considered **fully vaccinated** two weeks after receiving their second dose in a two-dose series (such as Pfizer or Moderna); or two weeks after receiving a single-dose vaccine (such as Johnson & Johnson Janssen). Berkeley reserves the right to request proof of vaccination at any time.

School of Health Studies Students

Students enrolled in education programs within the School of Health Studies may be expected to comply with additional health and safety requirements during their clinical rotation. Clinical rotation sites may require proof of COVID-19 vaccination and booster dose(s) and/or use of N95 or surgical masks.
