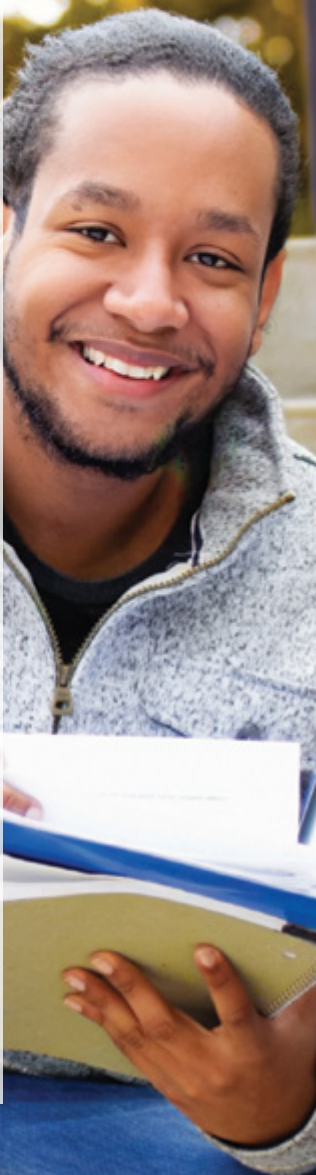

Through a partnership with Rennert International, Berkeley College offers international and domestic students the opportunity to improve their English skills in preparation for collegiate-level academics. Located at the New York City campus, Rennert International can help students gain full or conditional acceptance to Berkeley and help prepare them for life in the United States.

Military

Berkeley College has a longstanding commitment to the welfare and success of military students, veterans, and their families. Berkeley College supports the Post-9/11 GI Bill®, and provides Yellow Ribbon Grants to all eligible recipients. Berkeley College has partnered with the Department of Defense for all Military Tuition Assistance (TA) programs. The Military TA rate is extended to Active Duty, National Guard, Reserves, and their spouses for all degree programs including the MBA. We operate Veterans Resource Centers at four campuses and online.

Berkeley College also adheres to the terms of Executive Order 13607, *The Principles of Excellence*, and supports the United States Department of Education's *8 Keys to Veterans' Success*.

Student Services

Berkeley College students have access to a wide range of career-oriented academic programs, computer training, Library Services, Centers for Academic Success, Academic Advisement, Career Services, and a Student Development and Campus Life Department, which includes, but is not limited to, accessibility services for students with disabilities and health, counseling and wellness services.

Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI)

In the spirit of fostering a more equitable world, Berkeley College appointed a Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Advisory Committee. Career Services

Many Berkeley College students benefit from faculty-monitored internships, practicums, or job-related assignments prior to graduation.
