Research Planning Tools, Disclosures and a Limited FERPA Authorization

As a Military Tuition Assistance student considering pursuing a degree or certificate at Berkeley College, the College Admissions Department shall provide you with the following research tools and information to assist you, as you make this important decision:

- The College Scorecard is a planning tool available to evaluate options in selecting a school and is located at http://collegecost.ed.gov/scorecard/.
- The College Navigator is a research tool that provides information on tuition and fees, retention, graduation rates, use of financial aid, student loan default rates, cost calculator, and a school comparison tool at http://nces.ed.gov/collegenavigator.
- Berkeley College provides the Military Tuition Assistance Scholarship to cover tuition above the Military TA rate of \$250 per semester hour (<u>Berkeley College Grants and Scholarships</u>). This Scholarship can be compared with other institutions using the Pay for College Website by entering the financial aid offered information from up to three colleges at <u>http://www.consumerfinance.gov/paying-for-college/</u>. - Cohort Default Rate (CDR) The CDR is the percentage of a school's borrowers who enter repayment on Federal Family Education Loan (FFEL) Program or William D. Ford Federal Direct Loan (Direct Loan) Program loans during a federal cohort fiscal year (FY), October 1 to September 30, and default or meet other specified conditions prior to the end of the second following fiscal year. The Berkeley College FY2016 cohort default rate is 14.1% for New Jersey borrowers and 12.8% for New York borrows, compared to the 10.1% National average. The current percentage of federal loan borrowers is 80% in New Jersey and 65% in New York.
- Upon completion of your degree or certificate program, Berkeley College will provide an Official Transcript for your submission to your branch of service.
