FINANCIAL AID

To apply for financial aid, you must submit the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).

1. Create an FSA ID at fsaid.ed.gov
2. Next, log on to fafsa.ed.gov and click "Start Here." Be sure to use Berkeley College's school code in question #97.
